

Make an Easter Cross

Materials:

- 12 sugar cubes
- glue
- small sprigs of silk spring flowers (optional)

1. Count six sugar cubes. Arrange three cubes in a horizontal row. Glue the sides of the cubes together to form a base row. One by one, glue the bottoms and sides of the three remaining cubes to the base row. This will form the base of the cross. Set the base aside to dry for approximately ten minutes.
2. Count four cubes. Glue each cube, one on top of the other, to form a vertical row. Allow this vertical row to lay on a flat surface.
3. Count two cubes. Glue one side of each cube. Attach each of these cubes, one on one side and one on the other side, to the third cube in the vertical row. This will form the cross. Glue a sprig of a spring silk flower to the cross. (optional) Set the cross aside to dry for approximately fifteen minutes.
4. Gather together the dried base and cross. Attach the cross to the base by gluing the bottom cube of the cross to the middle cube of the base. Set aside to dry for approximately fifteen minutes.
5. Place your Easter cross in the family prayer space or other prominent place during the Easter season.
